Current Supplies


- The food stock and other perishable products are kept as small as possible to save energy and prevent loss.
- Our employees are trained to handle materials as carefully and efficiently as possible to prevent breakage and loss.
- Where possible, products are reused, repaired or recycled.
- The waste streams are carefully arranged.
- Current suppliers are reviewed for sustainability activities
- The number of suppliers has been drastically reduced to save administrative hassle and transport.

Future supplies

- Suppliers are assessed based on sustainability activities, distance from the hotel and production origin.
- Suppliers are assessed on the possession of certificates relating to sustainability and NEN standards.
- Products are reviewed on quality and sustainable materials
- Products that have direct consequences for damage to the environment are avoided as much as possible

This policy will be continuously reviewed throughout the year for updates and revisions based on relevant feedback and best practice.
